The story of life in every stitch

Maisha, a young resident of Mosabbir Alok Nibash, is bravely battling cancer. She and her mother have been staying at the care home while getting treatment, but the exhaustion from the illness and chemotherapy has taken a toll on both of them, mentally and physically. Maisha's mother shared that life has always had its challenges, but it never felt this overwhelming. Back in their village, she used to spend afternoons with other women, stitching quilts and sharing stories, while the children played nearby. These simple moments brought her peace and comfort. Conversations with other caregivers revealed similar longings for emotional support from such gatherings.

Mosabbir Alok Nibash is not just a place for physical healing—it also prioritizes the mental well-being of patients and their loved ones. To restore a sense of normalcy and joy, Alok Katha was created. Its primary goal is to ensure that the quiet moments at Mosabbir Alok Nibash are filled with purpose and creativity, rather than sorrow.

Every stitch in these handcrafted pieces holds stories of hope, struggle, and resilience. Alok Katha represents the embroidered narratives woven by cancer patients and their families during their time at Mosabbir Alok Nibash.

While Alok Katha currently focuses on embroidered textiles, we plan to expand into a range of handcrafted products in the future. We are already giving training to attendants. All proceeds from Alok Katha will go directly towards the rehabilitation of the patients at Mosabbir Alok Nibash.

At Alok Katha, we prioritize sustainability in every aspect of our work. All our products are thoughtfully packaged using eco-friendly materials, reflecting our dedication to protecting the environment. Most of the profits from our sales will go towards donations, directly supporting the rehabilitation and holistic care of cancer patients at Mosabbir Alok Nibash. A portion is also allocated to the attendants who create these products, empowering their livelihoods, while another portion is invested in marketing, logistics, and ensuring the initiative's continued growth and impact.
